

# Egg Sucking Leach Fly Tying Steps

1. Wrap Wire On Hook Shank - **OPTIONAL STEP** that adds weight for increased sinking
2. Snug Wire Up from Both Ends - clear up tag ends of wire as well
3. Begin Wrapping Thread Along the Hook - helps secure wire from sliding on the hook
4. Tie in Marabou Tail the Approx Length of Hook Shank - a little moisture helps make it more manageable and easier to work with
5. Tie in Black Trilobal Antron Chenille - strip off a little fiber to expose the white chenille core making it easier to tie in
6. Tie in Strung Saddle **BEFORE** Wrapping Chenille - tease out the feather
7. Begin Palmering Chenille Forward - tying off at the front of the hook, be sure to leave space for pink egg head
8. Palmer Strung Saddle Hackle Forward Stopping Where Chenille Ended
9. Knots like half-hitches at stopping points add security - half-hitches or whip finishes work great!
10. Begin Pink Thread and Tie In/Palmer Pink Chenille - orange and chartreuse heads can be good as well
11. Trim Chenille and Finish with a Knot - finish with a dab of head cement on thread
